

## Boys' Uniforms

*Revised*

- Navy blue dress pants - no patch pockets or jean style rivets
- Navy blue walking shorts - optional
- Light blue tailored shirt - short or long sleeve
- Dress belt in dark color - no large buckle
- Navy blue tie for Mass days/special occasions - solid color, no patterns
- Navy blue dress socks - crew length – no low cut sport style socks
- Non-athletic dress shoes in dark color - non-marking sole, no high cut boots
- Navy blue monogrammed coat sweater - optional – must be ordered through uniform company.
- School sweatshirt – optional – must be ordered through the school
- No earrings
- Hair must be neatly cut, clean, and well groomed – off the shirt collar and out of eyes – no faddish colors or styles
- T-shirts worn under dress shirts/polos must be plain white in color and fit properly as not to hang below short sleeves or at the bottom hem. **All shirts must be tucked in – not rolled at the waist.**

## Girls' Uniforms

- Navy blue plaid uniform skirt – all grade levels
- Navy blue plaid jumper – optional for grade K-3
- Navy blue kilt style skirt – optional for grades 6-8
- **All skirts must be hemmed no shorter than two inches above the knee.** Skirts should not be rolled at waistband. If shorts are worn under skirts/jumpers, they may not extend below the skirt.
- Navy blue dress slacks – optional – no patch pockets or jeans style rivets
- Navy blue walking shorts – optional
- Light blue tailored blouse – no ruffles, etc. – long or short sleeve
- Light blue polo shirt – long or short sleeve
- **All blouses must be tucked in and not rolled at waistband.**
- Navy blue knee socks with skirts or shorts.
- Navy blue socks with slacks – crew or knee length
- Navy blue tights – optional
- Non-athletic dress shoes – **no clogs, slides, sandals, open-toed shoes, crocs, etc.** - must be solid, dark colors, no pattern or sparkles, small heels only – non marking sole
- Navy blue monogrammed coat sweater – optional – ordered through uniform company
- School sweatshirt – optional – ordered through school
- Jewelry must be simple and small.
- Hair must be clean and well groomed and out of eyes - no faddish colors or styles.
- Hair accessories should be simple and coordinated with uniform.
- **Middle School students only** – Make-up, if worn must be simple and discreet.

### **Physical Education Dress Code**

Shorts or sweat pants of an appropriate length and fit – no short shorts

T-shirts – sleeved and crew neck – All must be school appropriate.

Gym socks

Tennis shoes – non-marking soles

**Casual Day Dress Code** - These days are announced in writing in advance.

Jeans, sweats – no holes or low cut styles

Sleeved T-shirts/sweat shirts – no tank tops, halter tops, see-through or mesh shirts

All tops must cover the waistband of the pants with arms fully extended.

A good measure for appropriateness in dress would be whether or not the style would call attention to the student or be disruptive to the learning environment as determined by the school staff. Students should come dressed for **academic success**, not **costumed**. In the event that the dress code is violated, appropriate clothing may be obtained from the uniform closet.
